RESERVATION INFORMATION

Canoe: \$140.00** (2 adults or 2 adults and 1 child)
Includes camping fee, canoe, paddles, bus ride up river,
and life vests. *Reservations must be made in advance!*

1-man Kayak: \$95.00** includes camping, paddle,
life preserver. *Reservations must be made in advance!*

Transportation-Only Fee: Canoes are \$40.00/Kayaks \$40.00.
People with their own canoes that need transportation upriver:
includes camping. Limited space. *Must reserve a spot.*

A NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT of \$20.00 per canoe/kayak is due
May 19th by check or money order. **YOUR CLEARED CHECK IS
YOUR ONLY RECEIPT.** (Returned checks cancel your reservation
and you will be responsible for any fees.)


**Final payment is due Friday, June 2nd, at the campground
by 8pm to Kristine L. IN CASH.** Payment in full must be
received by 8pm or your reservation will be given to the next
person on the waiting list! (Please pay in full in advance,
if you wish.) **PAYMENT MUST BE IN CASH IF PAYING AT THE
CANOE TRIP.**

FOR NON-CANOERS:

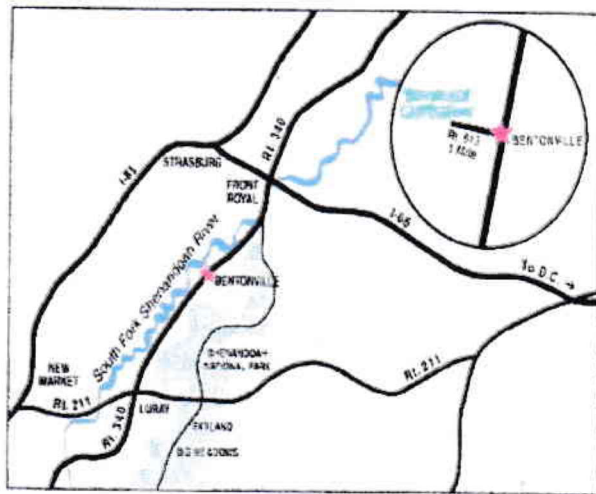
We welcome campers who want to join us but do not want to canoe.

DIRECTIONS TO OUR LOCATION

- Step 1: Follow I-66 West to Linden, Exit 13
- Step 2: Turn LEFT at the bottom of the ramp
- Step 3: Follow signs to SKYLINE DRIVE
- Step 4: Turn RIGHT on Rte 55, continue to Front Royal
- Step 5: Continue on Route 55 until it ends
- Step 6: Turn LEFT onto Rte 340
- Step 7: Pass through Bentonville
- Step 8: Continue south to Compton (4.5 miles south
of Bentonville)
- Step 9: Look for the  sign on the right side of road
- Step 10: Turn into the Down River Canoe
Company Campground
- Step 11: Set up camp and prepare for *X-treme* fun
- Step 12: Pass this on!
